


ANNUAL REPORT

Walker High School received \$12,000 that went to catering their first-ever prom, weekend meal kits, warm-up uniforms for their debut cheer squad, and seven driver's ed scholarships. Bethany also provided Christmas presents for 201 students and their families!

Olive Crest, an organization that supports foster kids and their families, was gifted \$27,600, fully funding a year of foster care support for 12 families.

Reep Village's "Clean Water Project" was completed in Nepal, giving 500 villagers safe water to their homes.

6 new wells dug in Democratic Republic of the Congo, serving 1,800 people.

Water partners include Water4, Medical Mercy Canada, and World Vision.

A letter from the Bethany Board Chairman – Ryan Funk

Dear Bethany Members,

I am so thankful to write to you for the first time as Chairman. George Hills left some large shoes to fill, but God is ever-faithful and knows what He is doing. Looking at and reflecting on 2023, I continue to be amazed at how God works in and through all things.

Last year, we saw Bethany make a further push into our local community with several outreach opportunities. The Easter Egg Hunt and Trunk or Treat events continue to draw large numbers of neighbors to our campus and I regularly hear stories of people who bring their children to one of those events and end up coming back to Bethany on a Sunday and turn into regular attenders. 2023 also saw the inaugural Community Outreach Offering on Easter Weekend. Mimicking Bethany's Water Offering at Christmas, last year all the money collected during our Easter services was given straight back to our local community partners. Building off our successful partnership with Wildwood Elementary School, we have now established partnerships with Ferrucci Jr. High and Walker High School.

A word that God continues to bring to me is Stewardship. In my time serving on the Bethany Board, I have witnessed firsthand the generosity of the Bethany congregation. From being able to pay off our mortgage in 2022 to our largest ever Water Offering in 2023, you have been so incredibly faithful in your giving. My daily prayer is that God would continually make us good stewards of the blessings that He has given.

The biggest item on the Board's agenda for 2023 ended up being discussions related to Pastor George's upcoming succession. He told me his plan several months ago and I am honored and humbled that I get to be a part of calling the next Senior Pastor for Bethany. I'm sure I could continue to write for pages but I will try to keep it brief. I attended Bethany during the last transition and I am so thankful that the Calling Committee faithfully listened to God and that the congregation at the time voted in Pastor George who has led Bethany well over the last nearly 20 years. Pastor George has committed to the Board that he wants to be part of a smooth transition and we have started talking about it like an Olympic-caliber baton pass in a relay race. Bethany isn't Pastor George's church – it's God's church and He already knows who the next Senior Pastor is going to be. Isn't that amazing? All we must do is listen. My goal is to be transparent and to communicate clearly as we, as the church, move through this transition together.

We will be holding the Annual Business Meeting this year where the budget, elected officers, and the Calling Committee members will be submitted for approval. As a member of Bethany, your prayers and vote matter and I am so thankful for your continued partnership. Finally, thank you for your love, prayers and support through this past year and for the privilege to serve God as your Chairman.
